Fast Facts

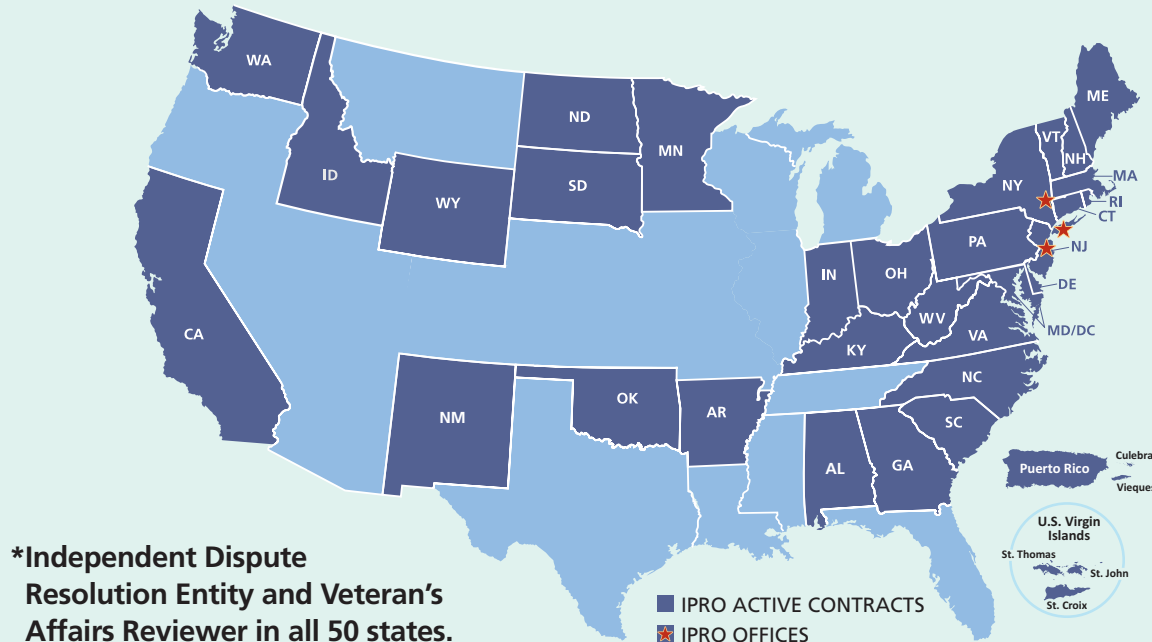
- Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Quality Improvement Organization (QIO) since 1989. Currently serving as the CMS QIN-QIO for Region 1 (Northeast) and Mid Atlantic (Region 2), impacting the care provided to 24% of the nation's Medicare beneficiaries.
- CMS End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Network contractor since 2006. Currently overseeing three Networks, 12 states, and nearly 20% of Medicare beneficiaries living with ESRD.
- CMS ESRD Kidney Health Analytics and Responsive Emergency Support (KHARES) contractor, providing infrastructure, technical assistance (TA), and coordination support, and leading national emergency management for all 18 ESRD Networks across the United States.
- Medicaid External Quality Review Organization (EQRO) contracts in 11 states.
- 18 Independent Review Organization (IRO) contracts in 16 states and the District of Columbia.
- Independent Dispute Resolution (IDR) Entity since implementation of the federal No Surprises Act in 2022, closing nearly 500,000 cases over the program's first four years.
